42c - Treatment of Residents

1. Requirements

2600.

42.c. A resident shall be treated with dignity and respect.

Description of Violation

On the evening of [REDACTED] resident #1 wandered into a female resident's room with their pants down. Resident #2 believed resident #1 was going to harm another resident and punched resident #2 in the face. Both residents were sent to the local ER for a medical evaluation. No injuries resulted in the resident-to-resident altercation.

Plan of Correction

1. Corrected on 11/3/2023.

2. Direct Care Staff will monitor residents for any signs of agitation or aggression. If any of the staff become concern for a resident they will be place on Q15 checks for 24 hours and Direct Care staff will intervene to keep residents from one another.

3. Direct Care Staff performing Q15 minute checks will re-evaluate after 24 hours to see if the checks are still necessary. If there are no longer any signs of agitation or aggression Direct Care Staff will lift the Q15 minute checks.

2600.

227.d. Each home shall document in the resident's support plan the medical, dental, vision, hearing, mental health or other behavioral care services that will be made available to the resident, or referrals for the resident to outside services if the resident's physician, physician's assistant or certified registered nurse practitioner, determine the necessity of these services. This requirement does not require a home to pay for the cost of these medical and behavioral care services.

Resident #2's RASP dated [REDACTED] was not updated to reflect Resident #2's psychiatric Hospital stay and psychiatric evaluation [REDACTED] due to the resident's increased agitation and resident to resident altercations.
