Administrative assistant immediately updated Resident #1's assessment to reflect residents' irritability, agitation and aggressive behaviors during ADL's. Administrator and/or administrative assistant will review all resident assessments to check for accuracy. This check will be completed by 10/30/23. Checks of all assessments will be documented, and documentation will be filed in administrators' office.
