42b - Abuse

1. Requirements

2600.

42.b. A resident may not be neglected, intimidated, physically or verbally abused, mistreated, subjected to corporal punishment or disciplined in any way.

Description of Violation

According to residents #1 and #2's progress notes, staff members witnessed inappropriate behaviors from resident #1 towards resident #2 as indicated below:

- [REDACTED]: Resident #1 was observed putting [REDACTED] hand under resident #2's shirt and touching [REDACTED] breasts
- [REDACTED]: Resident #1 was observed touching resident #2's breasts and buttock area over resident #2's clothing
- [REDACTED]: Resident #2 was found sitting on resident #1's lap with resident #1's hands around resident #2's waist
- [REDACTED]: Resident #1 grabbed resident #2's private area over top of [REDACTED] clothes

Plan of Correction

On 11/5/2023 all staff were educated by the PCHA on abuse reporting and regulation 2600.42b. (DIRECTED: Documentation of the staff education shall be kept in accordance with 2600.65i. [REDACTED] 11/17/23). On 11/4/2023 resident # 1 was assigned a 1:1 caregiver during waking hours in addition to a silent bed alarm that was installed on 11/4/2023 in his room that will alert the nurse immediately if he gets out of bed during the night. Residents RASP was updated by PCHA on 11/4/2023 to reflect 1:1 caregiver during waking hours, and silent bed alarm at night. Resident # 1 was also issued a 30 day notice on 11/1/2023 by PCHA and referrals were made to find [REDACTED] appropriate placement.

PCHA or designee will conduct interviews with 5 residents per week for 4 weeks, then monthly for three months, and then randomly thereafter to ensure ongoing compliance with regulation 2600.42b. Resident interviews shall begin the week of 11/6/2023. Documentation of these interviews will be retained by the PCHA with a completion date of 2/6/2024.

Education on Regulation 2600.42b will continue with staff monthly for 3 months and annually thereafter. PCHA will retain documentation of the staff education in accordance with regulation 2600.65i. (DIRECTED: The monthly staff training shall begin on 12/1/23 and shall include training for all current staff persons. LM 11/17/23).
