Staff member A was witnessed and admitted to using profanity and disrespectful language in the presence of residents while in a common area of the home.

Plan of Correction

Staff member A was immediately pulled from the floor and taken off the schedule. Executive Director completed an internal investigation and ultimately terminated the associate. The Executive Director also followed up with two trainings at the next all staff meeting on Jan. 18, 2024 on the topics of "Elder Abuse" in addition to "Professionalism in the workplace" (see attached) to retrain all associates on the importance of using appropriate language in the presence of residents.
