144c1 - Smoking Area Guidelines

1. Requirements

2600.

144.c. A home that permits smoking inside or outside of the home shall develop and implement written fire safety policy and procedures that include the following:

- 1. Proper safeguards inside and outside of the home to prevent fire hazards involved in smoking, including providing fireproof receptacles and ashtrays, direct outside ventilation, no interior ventilation from the smoking room through other parts of the home, extinguishing procedures, fire resistant furniture both inside and outside the home and fire extinguishers in the smoking rooms.

Description of Violation

Approximately 20 cigarette butts were noted on the 2nd floor smoking porch, posing a possible fire hazard.

Effective immediately and on-going; new cigarette receptacles have been purchased that can only be opened via a key that will be kept on staff at all times. A checklist was created and implemented immediately by the administrator and assistant administrator to prompt the direct care professionals to check and clean the smoking areas for any cigarette butts on the ground, for any flammable materials in or around the smoking areas, and for any possible fire hazards every 30 minutes and initial that the check has been completed during their shift. The checklist will be audited daily by the administrator and/or assistant administrator daily to ensure compliance.

144.c. A home that permits smoking inside or outside of the home shall develop and implement written fire safety policy and procedures that include the following:

- 2. A home that permits smoking inside or outside of the home shall develop and implement written fire safety policy and procedures that include the following: Location of a smoking room or outside smoking area a safe distance from heat sources, hot water heaters, combustible or flammable materials and away from common walkways and exits.

Description of Violation

Empty cigarette packs, tissues a lighter and garbage were noted in the butt cans in the homes 2nd floor porch smoking area. The top half of a smoking urn was noted on the porch, a pile of cigarette butts that were smoking were noted under the urn. Residents are putting their cigarette butts in this receptacle although it doesn't have a bottom. The butts were directly on the porch under the urn. The above noted items pose a fire hazard.

Salisbury Behavioral Health understands the importance of regulation 144.c. Effective immediately and on-going; the smoking urn that posed a fire hazard has been removed from the smoking area and new cigarette receptacles have been purchased that can only be opened via a key that will be kept on staff at all times. A staff meeting was held on 1/25/24 to educate the direct support professionals on the importance of regulation 144.c. and what the procedure
