Description of Violation

On [REDACTED], at approximately [REDACTED] staff person A was assisting resident [REDACTED] with dressing and getting out of bed. Resident [REDACTED] that when the resident asked staff person A to be careful with [REDACTED] leg due to a recent injury that requires [REDACTED] wearing a brace, staff person A shocked the resident when [REDACTED] disrespectfully replied for the resident to shut up and that [REDACTED] knows what [REDACTED] is doing. The resident reports that staff person A appeared to be angry.

Plan of Correction

Accept [REDACTED] - 02/20/2024)

1. Staff person A was educated on [REDACTED] prior to being placed back on schedule regarding Residents Rights and dignity/respect. Discussed proper and positive communication techniques.
2. All staff will be educated on Resident Rights and dignity/respect by March 5, 2024. Documentation will be kept.
3. Starting 2/19/24 weekly for 4 weeks, Executive Director or designee will conduct 25 random resident audits that includes residents cared for by staff person A. Documentation will be kept.
3. All staff will be educated again regarding Resident Rights and respect/dignity by 4/30/24. Documentation will be kept.
