15a - Resident Abuse Report

1. Requirements

2600.

15.a. The home shall immediately report suspected abuse of a resident served in the home in accordance with the Older Adult Protective Services Act (35 P. S. § § 10225.701—10225.707) and 6 Pa. Code § 15.21—15.27 (relating to reporting suspected abuse) and comply with the requirements regarding restrictions on staff persons.

Description of Violation

On [redacted] staff person A was overheard by staff person B yelling at resident [redacted]. Staff person A had accused resident [redacted] of lying about falling in the shower. Staff B overheard staff person A angrily talking about this within earshot of resident [redacted] and also overheard staff person A yelling at resident [redacted] that they could lose their job because of resident [redacted] lying. Staff person B did not immediately report the emotional abuse to management or to the area agency on aging.

Plan of Correction

Staff person B was reminded of the reporting procedures by the administrator. At the next staff meeting the administrator will review resident rights, the resident abuse and reporting regulations, and the reporting policies of Renaissance homes. The staff meeting is scheduled for [redacted]. Update: staff meeting has been postponed due to a schedule conflict. New staff meeting scheduled [redacted]. The administrator will monitor ongoing compliance. The administrator will also show the staff members the resident right posters that are in the building so that they can refer to them at any time.

2. Requirements

2600.

42.c. A resident shall be treated with dignity and respect.

Description of Violation

On [redacted] staff person A was overheard yelling at resident [redacted] by staff person B. Resident [redacted] reported that staff person A came into their room and called them a liar. Staff person A proceeded to speak loudly to another staff person about resident [redacted] lying about falling in the shower. Resident [redacted] overheard this and became upset and denied lying about falling. Staff person A responded by telling resident [redacted] that they did lie and that now staff person A could lose their job. Resident [redacted] was subjected to emotional abuse by staff person A.

Plan of Correction

Staff person A was suspended immediately upon the home was notified of the incident and then was terminated. At the next staff meeting the administrator will review resident rights, the resident abuse and reporting regulations, and the reporting policies of Renaissance homes.
