16c - Written Incident Report

1. Requirements

2600.

16.c. The home shall report the incident or condition to the Department’s personal care home regional office or the personal care home complaint hotline within 24 hours in a manner designated by the Department. Abuse reporting shall also follow the guidelines in § 2600.15 (relating to abuse reporting covered by law).

Description of Violation

On [redacted] between [redacted] and [redacted], resident [redacted] had an unwitnessed fall in the resident’s bedroom. The resident was found on the floor around [redacted] by direct care staff person A at the bed side trying to get up from the floor unsuccessfully. Resident [redacted] was sent to the hospital via EMS and presented with a broken/bloody nose, multiple superficial 3” diameter abrasions on the resident’s bilateral feet and left knee, and a deep 3” x 4” tree shaped abrasion on the resident’s right knee. The resident was admitted to the hospital for [redacted], and [redacted] with [redacted]. However, the home did not report the incident to the Department.

Plan of Correction

On December 13 &14 education has been conducted to all staff by [redacted] PC Administrator. The following items were communicated and protocols reinforced.

- 1.Christ The King Manor will report incidents or conditions to Department of Human Services personal Care Home regional office or the personal care home complaint hotline within 24 hours of the occurrence in accords to the department’s requirements.
- 2. Staff members will check on residents in our secured unit every 2 hours with documentation of such. The Personal Care Home Administrator will be responsible for reviewing documentation checks weekly to ensure compliance. The PC Administrator will be responsible for reviewing all incidents on a quarterly basis to ensure that all required reporting was completed, and the results will be included in Christ The King Manors quality management reviews starting in January 2024
