88a - Surfaces

1. Requirements

2600.

88.a. Floors, walls, ceilings, windows, doors and other surfaces must be clean, in good repair and free of hazards.

Description of Violation

The Home's Activity room/TV Room had coffee spilled on the floor that had dried and was sticky and dirty where it remained on the floor surface.

Resident Room [redacted] is dirty with spots of dirt on the floor and small bits of debris and hair on the floor in need of sweeping or vacuuming. It also needs wiping down in the dirty areas.

Plan of Correction

Accept [redacted] - 03/15/2024)

Immediately on [redacted] the home's activity room floor was cleaned. Also resident room [redacted] floor was swept, mopped and wiped down the surface areas that were dirty. Moving forward the staff will conduct daily activity room checks, common area checks and resident room checks. The administrator and program manager will review that staff are completing the daily shift check spread sheet and document. I have attached the spread sheet for the daily shift checks. These daily shift checks started on [redacted]. I've also included pictures of the activity room and resident room [redacted].

144c1 - Smoking Area Guidelines

2. Requirements

2600.

144.c. A home that permits smoking inside or outside of the home shall develop and implement written fire safety policy and procedures that include the following:

1. Proper safeguards inside and outside of the home to prevent fire hazards involved in smoking, including providing fireproof receptacles and ashtrays, direct outside ventilation, no interior ventilation from the smoking room through other parts of the home, extinguishing procedures, fire resistant furniture both inside and outside the home and fire extinguishers in the smoking rooms.

Description of Violation

Upon arrival at the home, this worker observed a large number of cigarette butts in the parking lot between the Smoking Gazebo and the front door of the home. Parking spaces between the Gazebo and the front door of the home had in excess of 30 + cigarette butts in evidence.

Staff and/or residents and/or visitors are discarding cigarette butts in the parking lot, not in a proper receptacle, and not in the designated smoking area.

144c1 - Smoking Area Guidelines (continued)

Plan of Correction**Accept** [REDACTED] - 03/15/2024)

Immediately on [REDACTED] the cigarette butts were swept up from the parking lot. A new receptacle was purchased and placed near the front door for cigarette disposal only. Although the residents were smoking in the designated smoking area there were disposing the cigarette in the parking lot. The administrator educated the residents of the importance of properly disposing the cigarette and made them aware of the new receptacle. Moving forward the staff will conduct daily smoke area checks. The administrator and program manager will review that staff are completing the daily shift check spread sheet and document. I have attached the spread sheet for the daily shift checks. These daily shift checks started on [REDACTED]. I've also included pictures of the new receptacle and cleaned grounds.
