2600.

42.b. A resident may not be neglected, intimidated, physically or verbally abused, mistreated, subjected to corporal punishment or disciplined in any way.

Description of Violation

On [REDACTED], at approximately [REDACTED], staff person A was responding to a call bell in resident room [REDACTED]. Staff person A noticed resident [REDACTED] was not in the room; however, staff person B was rummaging through resident [REDACTED] personal belongings. On or about [REDACTED], resident [REDACTED] reported to staff person C that [REDACTED] in cash and [REDACTED] debit card was missing. Resident [REDACTED] stated to an agent of the Department that someone attempted an unauthorized purchase of [REDACTED] on card but it was declined. Staff person B was terminated from employment at the home.

Repeat violation: 10/27/23 et al

Plan of Correction

Accept [REDACTED] - 03/08/2024)

Staff person B was suspended [REDACTED] and terminated on [REDACTED] after full investigation. Facility then reimbursed Resident [REDACTED] dollars with signed receipt. Resident [REDACTED] was offered and accepted a locked drawer for [REDACTED] room. The administrator will conduct a staff education on misappropriation of property, Training will start Monday March 11th and be completed by March 15th, training records will be kept in the education binder with each employees training sheet being placed in their employee file. Administrator will interview 5 residents a week for two weeks (Monday the 11th and Monday the 18th) focused on misappropriation of property. Administrator/Designee will survey residents in monthly resident council with questions relating to misappropriation. This will begin March 22nd. Minutes are kept in the resident council binder.
