**Description of Violation**

*The support plan for resident [REDACTED] dated 10-10-24 did not include an update indicating the resident was having an increase in depression, was placed on a 15 minute watch or had expressed suicidal ideation. A review of resident's chart had documentation of a physician communication form dated 2-29-24 indicating resident had expressed suicidal ideation. Nursing notes from 3-4-24 and 3-5-24 indicate an increase in depression.*

**Plan of Correction****Accept [REDACTED] - 04/10/2024)**

*Immediate correction on 3-7-24 Resident [REDACTED] was transported to Emergency room for change in condition. Staff member C. Chilson made the phone call.*

*Resident no longer resides at our facility as of 3-31-24 due to needing higher level of care.*

*Review of resident charts have been completed for any change in conditions. Currently, no residents support plans need updated.*

*Preventive step: As staff report a change of condition to Administrator and/or Director of Wellness, the Administrator and/or DOW will review resident charts and pull DME and support plan to make any necessary changes and updates coordinating with physician.*

*Staff educated on the importance of informing DOW and Administrator of resident change in condition of physical or mental health. Training date 3/9/2024.*

*Compliance monitor: Administrator and DOW will discuss resident change in conditions daily, will update DME and support plan as needed.*

*Changes that are identified for a resident will be updated by PCP on Thursday doctor visits, will have 1 day to complete support plan after receiving completed DME.*

*Monthly Q&A meetings: Plan of correction will be reviewed and monitoring in place to ensure on going compliance. Administrator will oversee.*
