1. Requirements

2800.

142.a. Each residence shall demonstrate the ability to provide or arrange for the provision of supplemental health care services in a manner protective of the health, safety and well-being of its residents utilizing employees, independent contractors or contractual arrangements with other health care facilities or practitioners licensed, registered or certified to the extent required by law to provide the service.

Description of Violation

On [redacted] at approximately 7:30pm resident [redacted] suffered a fall. Resident [redacted] lives in the home's secure care unit and has a diagnosis of [redacted]. Resident [redacted] was unable to bear weight immediately after the fall and showed signs of discomfort. Due to the resident's family declining to have the resident sent to the hospital, Resident [redacted] was not sent for evaluation until [redacted] at approximately 5:00am. Resident [redacted] had shown signs of increasing pain throughout the night. Resident [redacted] was diagnosed with a [redacted] at the hospital on [redacted].

Plan of Correction

The Executive Director had a meeting with the Director of Nursing, on 4/2/2024 to review the listed 142a. All falls in our Memory Care Unit that involve a resident exhibiting discomfort must be sent to the hospital immediately. The Director of Nursing, had verbal conversations with Nurses and Medication Technicians on April 2nd, 2024. Director of Nursing will train medication technicians and nurses on proper pain assessments. Hayley Cinti, the Director of Nursing, will review effective ways to communicate with families who oppose sending their resident to the emergency room during the training. This training will be completed by 4/30/2024
