Resident #1 has an enabler bar on his/her bed. However, the bar is not secured to the bed and can be moved from the mattress approximately 12 inches, posing an entrapment hazard.

On April 12th we had the Bureau of Human service Licensing inspection . The inspector found that the resident # 1 had an enabler bar which was not secured to the bed. Immediately the Administrator removed the bar from the bed, In future if we use the device we will secure the the device to the bed according to the manufactures direction. The administrator corrected on 4-12- 2024.
