23a - Activities of Daily Living Assistance

1. Requirements

2600.

23.a. A home shall provide each resident with assistance with ADLs as indicated in the resident's assessment and support plan.

Description of Violation

Resident #1 is a person with [REDACTED]. According to [REDACTED] assessment and support plan, dated [REDACTED] direct care staff are to assist her with transfer into and out of a bed or chair using a mechanical lift. On [REDACTED], while using a sit-to-stand device with a standing sling to lift resident #1, [REDACTED] received a [REDACTED] skin tear on [REDACTED] left shin requiring 27 stitches to treat due to [REDACTED] leg brushing against part of the sit-to-stand device.

Plan of Correction

Accept ([REDACTED] - 06/28/2024)

2600.23a

Description of the immediate repair:

On 3/1/24, PCHA completed education with PC staff regarding regulation 2600.23a as well as education on the safe use of mechanical lifts and transfer techniques for residents. Also on 3/1/24, PCHA requested an order from the residents PCP for a therapy evaluation and recommendation. PCHA shall retain documentation of all staff education.

Long Term Plan for the Problem:

On 5/1/24, the Director of Rehab services completed and in-service training with all PC staff on the use of mechanical lifts and transfer techniques. PCHA will retain documentation of this training. Education regarding regulation 2600.23a was completed on 3/1/24 and will continue annually. Documentation of the annual training shall be retained by the PCHA.

Monitoring Plan:

PCHA or designee will audit 5 random residents transfer status according to their RASP and will observe staff transferring the residents to ensure the RASP is being followed to ensure compliance with regulation 2600.23a. Audits and observations shall begin on 7/01/2024 and will be done monthly for 3 months and randomly thereafter. PCHA will retain documentation of the completed audits and observations.
