Description of Violation

On [REDACTED] during the daylight shift, staff person A assisted resident [REDACTED] with a shower. During the shower, resident [REDACTED] reported that staff person A was rough with resident [REDACTED] and appeared to be rushing resident [REDACTED] through the shower process.

Plan of Correction

Accept [REDACTED] - 06/04/2024)

1. Upon report from resident, staff person A was suspended pending investigation by Executive Director.
2. On 5/22/24, staff person A was educated by Resident Care Manager on resident rights- treatment of residents. Also educated on proper communication during shower process. (Documentation attached)
3. Starting week of 5/26/24 for 4 weeks, Executive Director and Resident Care Manager will interview 20 residents regarding treatment with dignity and respect. Residents interviewed will include those cared for by staff person A. (Documentation will be kept).
4. By 6/15/24, all staff will be educated on resident rights- Treatment of Residents by department managers. (Documentation will be kept)
5. By 7/15/24, all staff will be educated on resident rights- Treatment of Residents by department managers. (Documentation will be kept).
6. Staff person A was observed 5/22/24 and 5/23/24 during care of 13 residents each day by staff member [REDACTED]. Documentation kept
7. Staff person A participated in a training class on 5/30/24 for 8 hours with [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] providing supervised care of residents and review of policies.
8. POC will be reviewed in the next QM on 6/12/24. Documentation will be kept.
