1. Requirements

2600.

227.d. Each home shall document in the resident’s support plan the medical, dental, vision, hearing, mental health or other behavioral care services that will be made available to the resident, or referrals for the resident to outside services if the resident’s physician, physician’s assistant or certified registered nurse practitioner, determine the necessity of these services. This requirement does not require a home to pay for the cost of these medical and behavioral care services.

Description of Violation

The current RASP dated [redacted] states that resident [redacted] is on a regular diet but there is a order dated [redacted] that indicates resident [redacted] was changed to a mechanical soft diet.

Information regarding incontinence, use of incontinence briefs, and physical assist of one staff when incontinence occurs is not documented in most current RASP, dated [redacted] for Resident [redacted]

Plan of Correction

Action: On [redacted], the Director of Nursing updated the Resident Assessment and Support Plan for Resident [redacted] Resident [redacted] was deceased when this inspection occurred.

Training: On 6/19/2024, the Regional Director of Clinical Services educated the Director of Nursing on using the Resident Assessment and Support Plan audit tool. The Executive Director will educate the Director of Nursing and Resident Care Coordinator on Regulation 2600.227d by 7/1/2024.

Ongoing: The Executive Director, Director of Nursing and Resident Care Coordinator will complete an audit of current Resident Assessments and Support Plans, identify any issues, and update as necessary to ensure compliance by 8/1/2024. Resident Assessments and Support Plans will be reviewed by the Director of Nursing, Resident Care Coordinator and Executive Director upon completion starting 7/1/2024. This will be reviewed at monthly Quality Assurance meetings starting August 2024.
