82c Locking Poisonous Materials

1. Requirements

2600.

82.c. Poisonous materials shall be kept locked and inaccessible to residents unless all of the residents living in the home are able to safely use or avoid poisonous materials.

Description of Violation

On [REDACTED] at about [REDACTED], Resident # 1 was able to access the laundry room of the SDCU and found a laundry detergent pod, brand unknown, which [REDACTED] partially ingested. [REDACTED] then was found walking down the hallway towards the staff with foam coming from [REDACTED] mouth and a grimace on [REDACTED] face.

Staff members immediately determined what had transpired, found the laundry room ajar and proceeded to follow the Home's Poison Control Incident Protocols immediately based on the substance data sheets.

The resident was given water to drink, vomited, became lethargic, and 911 was summoned immediately.

In the meantime, by additional staff, upon further inspection it became apparent that the laundry room door auto lock function was not working, and the laundry detergent was immediately removed from the room and secured.

The home is working on a repair or replacement to the faulty auto lock feature of the laundry room door.

Plan of Correction

Accept [REDACTED] - 08/26/2024)

- The resident was immediately cared for by the nurse on duty to ensure [REDACTED] safety on [REDACTED]
- The door was closed and was locked on [REDACTED] at the time of the incident.
- Laundry room door closing mechanism was changed to ensure the door self closes more quickly without needing physical assistance. The new closing mechanism was installed on 7/9/2024.
- Automatic laundry detergent dispensers were installed by the preferred vendor on 8/8/2024 to eliminate the need to have any other types of detergent that would be in a container or pod form.
- The facility will conduct a training to review the organization's Policy and Procedure related to Poisonous Materials with SDCU co-workers on or before 9/1/24.
- Effective on 7.7.24 the department manager is responsible for ongoing compliance with this plan of correction.
