1. Requirements

2600.

183.e. Prescription medications, OTC medications and CAM shall be stored in an organized manner under proper conditions of sanitation, temperature, moisture and light and in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions.

Description of Violation

Resident [redacted]'s medication is packaged weekly, by the home's contracted pharmacy, into reusable multidose medication cassettes. The cassette compartments, containing the resident's medication, was observed to have brown spots scattered throughout the container and did not appear to be clean.
