42c - Treatment of Residents

1. Requirements

2600.

42.c. A resident shall be treated with dignity and respect.

Description of Violation

Resident [redacted] slapped and pushed resident [redacted] after being involved in a verbal confrontation regarding missing food items from the resident's shared room. Neither resident had injury or requested medical attention.

Resident [redacted] pushed resident [redacted] after being confronted while in resident [redacted] room using the bathroom. Resident [redacted] also took food items and defecated on the resident's floor while using the bathroom. Neither resident had injury nor requested medical attention.

Plan of Correction

Accept [redacted] - 11/04/2024)

Resident [redacted] was immediately relocated to Room [redacted] from Room [redacted]. Both Resident [redacted] and Resident [redacted] were made aware as to not make contact with one another and re-educated in Resident Rights as per their signed contractual agreement. Both Resident [redacted] and Resident [redacted] were placed on hourly checks to ensure no continuous contact was made.

Resident [redacted] was immediately removed from Resident [redacted] Room [redacted] and placed on a 15-minute check. Resident [redacted] and Resident [redacted] reside on opposite sides of the facility, therefore minimal contact, if any, was made. Resident [redacted] was evaluated by [redacted] CRNP, [redacted], on [redacted], and has since been issued a 30-day notice for the recommendation of a higher level of care. Resident [redacted] was re-educated in Resident Rights as per [redacted] signed contractual agreement.

Moving forward, the Administrator, Assistant Administrator, and/or the Marketing Director, will perform a higher quality assessment upon admission of all potential residents to ensure placement, whether privately or semi-privately is acceptable and suitable to allow and ensure ongoing compliance to DHS Regulations. Starting 11/11/2024, the Administrator and/or the Assistant Administrator will perform monthly audits with all shared room Residents to further evaluate and assess ongoing living arrangements and relationships to maintain on going compliance with DHS Regulations.
