Description of Violation

In June 2024 Resident [redacted] gifted a total of [redacted] to Staff Member A. A check for [redacted] and [redacted] in cash was accepted by the staff member. Staff Member A accepted the monetary gifts from Resident [redacted] despite being aware of the home's no-gift policy and without regard for the financial wellbeing of the resident.

Plan of Correction

Accept [redacted] - 11/27/2024)

On 8/30/2024 resident representative Nicole informed administrator of misappropriation of resident funds. On 8/30/2024 resident interviewed. Employee A was suspended during investigation. Wilkes-Barre police department notified and officer [redacted] arrived on site and interviewed resident. On 8/30/2024 AAA notified, [redacted] arrived on site to interview resident. Allied security notified. Resident representative updated. On 9/3/2024 facility investigation concluded that employee A violated the homes Gifts and Tips Policy and Abuse, Neglect, Misappropriation of Property Policy and employment was terminated. Resident deemed capable to gift his money per AAA [redacted], and supervisor [redacted] Resident declined to press charges with WB police department against employee A. Resident offered emotional support and reassurance. Resident representative updated. All staff were re-educated on homes Gifts and Tips Policy and Abuse, Neglect, Misappropriation of Property Policy. All staff will be re-educated annually on Gifts and Tips Policy and Abuse, Neglect, Misappropriation of Property Policy. All residents will be educated on Gifts and Tips Policy during monthly House Meetings.
