They will document completion of the cart check weekly starting [redacted] and continue for at least 6 months and will be re-evaluated by the Nursing AVP at that time.

Resident [redacted] is prescribed [redacted] apply two daily and [redacted] capsules twice daily at 8:00 A.M. and 8:00 P.M.. However, these medications were not administered to Resident [redacted] on 10/1/24 at 8:00 A.M. because the medications were not available in the home.

The MTS Trainer, completed a cart check on [redacted] at 3pm and located both [redacted] and Fish Oil in the med cart. Resident [redacted] prescribed [redacted] and [redacted] were administered at 8pm on [redacted]. The MTS trainer will train the medication certified Life Skill Trainers in Beechwood Center #1 on the steps to reorder medication in a timely manner on [redacted]. The MAR's will be reviewed by the PCHA weekly to monitor for supply starting [redacted]. The reviews will continue for at least 6 months and will be re-evaluated at that time.

Resident [redacted] is prescribed [redacted] 1 tablet by mouth twice daily for 5 days starting [redacted]. However, Resident [redacted] was not administered [redacted] on [redacted] at 8:00 P.M. and [redacted] at 8:00 A.M.

On [redacted] upon report of the missing medication, the RN located the [redacted] in the med cart and administered the antibiotic at 12pm. [redacted] training was created by the Nursing AVP and trained to the PCHA on [redacted]. The PCHA will train their staff on [redacted] on the proper ways to clean the CPAP machine and log it on the MAR. The MAR's will be reviewed by the PCHA weekly to monitor for errors starting on [redacted]. The reviews will continue for at least 6 months and will be re-evaluated at that time.
