Staff Member A was immediately sent home and suspended from all duties during investigation and inspection of reportable incident. After on-site inspections from Northampton County Area on Aging on 10/18/2024 and DHS on 10/24/2024, Staff Member A was notified via standard and certified mail of the termination of employment from Alexandria Manor. Both Administrator, Heather Smith, and Assistant Administrator, Robyn Brown, are registered to complete DHS Continuing Education Class DHS105. (11) of Prevention of Abuse and Neglect on November 21, 2024, from 9am-12pm. All staff will be re-educated in Prevention of Abuse and Neglect with Verbal De-Escalation Redirection Techniques on December 9, 2024, at 9am and 4pm by Administrator, Heather Smith and Assistant Administrator, Robyn Brown. These two continuing educations will be incorporated into our education programs, not only annually, but quarterly to ensure compliance with Regulation 42b is maintained and sustained.
