182b - Prescription Medication

1. Requirements

2600.

182.b. Prescription medication that is not self-administered by a resident shall be administered by one of the following:

- 4. A staff person who has completed the medication administration training as specified in § 2600.190 (relating to medication administration training) for the administration of oral; topical; eye, nose and ear drop prescription medications; insulin injections and epinephrine injections for insect bites or other allergies.

Description of Violation

On [redacted], Staff Person A administered [redacted] to resident #1. Staff person A is an unlicensed staff and is not qualified to administer [redacted] medications.

Plan of Correction

Accept [redacted] - 11/07/2024)

I, [redacted], the owner and administrator was not aware of the additional two hours of training needed to be able to assist the resident with a GLP-1 injection. [redacted] has been on that for a very long time for diabetes. Our diabetic educator at UPMC - Western Maryland teaches this in the 4-hour diabetic training we receive yearly, along with the insulin injection training.

On October 24, 2024, I reached out to the providers for the (2) residents that receive a GLP-1 injection for their diabetes, and explained the situation, that we were unable to assist them with the injections till we receive the required training for GLP-1 medications.

On November 1, 2024 we received a letter for each resident saying that they could give their own injections. I have attached the letters.

November 1, 2024 I contacted the diabetic educator at UPMC Western MD and made her aware that we will need a additional 2-hour training on the GLP-1 injections for our next scheduled diabetic training, until then the residents will administer their own injection.
