Description of Violation

Resident [redacted] pushed Resident [redacted] onto the elevator floor after they had become frustrated with Resident [redacted]. Resident [redacted] fell to the ground and bumped their head and knee. The [redacted] Residents were separated and Resident [redacted] left via ambulance to get an evaluation at the emergency room. Resident [redacted] returned to the home later that day with no injuries and no follow up orders.

Plan of Correction

On [redacted] resident [redacted] pushed resident [redacted] to the ground while riding together in the elevator. Resident [redacted] was sent to the ER for evaluation purposes. Resident [redacted] returned home from the ER the same day with no notable injuries.

On [redacted] a meeting was held with Resident [redacted] and [redacted] to discuss the incident that occurred on [redacted]. In the meeting the house rules were discussed along with the importance of treating their peers with dignity and respect. See attached. Moving forward the administrator will remind the residents of the importance of healthy boundaries and respect for all their peers during our regular monthly house meeting with the residents.
