## 42c - Treatment of Residents

## 1. Requirements

2600.

42.c. A resident shall be treated with dignity and respect.

**Description of Violation**

*In the morning of [REDACTED], during the 11:00 p.m. – 7:00 a.m. shift, resident [REDACTED] felt dizzy and states that [REDACTED] either slid or fell out of the chair in [REDACTED] room. [REDACTED] got to the nightstand and pushed [REDACTED] call bell pendant. Staff person A responded to the call bell. The resident stated that [REDACTED] had vomit on [REDACTED] mouth and face, and had had a bowel movement. Staff person A responded to the call bell and called for assistance from the medication technician on duty, staff person B. Staff person B came to the resident's room and called for an ambulance. As the EMS personnel were entering the resident's room and staff person A was exiting the room, staff person A stated, "[REDACTED] [REDACTED]" Resident [REDACTED] heard the comment. The resident stated this comment made [REDACTED] feel "Low. Like I wasn't worth nothing to [REDACTED]."*

**Plan of Correction**

Accept [REDACTED] - 01/21/2025)

*On 12/9/2024, Immediately paced staff person A on direct supervision plan, and planned for staff member to be scheduled to work on 2nd floor, away from floor where resident resides. Planned education on 2600.42c. on 12/10/25. Staff person A did not arrive for shift that night and was separated based on multiple violations of attendance policy. On 12/10/2024, Admin completed internal investigation of staff person A with staff and residents regarding 2600.42c. Education on Resident Rights to be completed by 1/31/25 for all staff members. Starting in Jan 2025, completing 1x/month, for 4 months, Admin will complete interviews of 10 random residents to ensure compliance of 2600.42.c.*
