182b - Prescription Medication**1. Requirements**

2600.

182.b. Prescription medication that is not self-administered by a resident shall be administered by one of the following:

4. A staff person who has completed the medication administration training as specified in § 2600.190 (relating to medication administration training) for the administration of oral; topical; eye, nose and ear drop prescription medications; insulin injections and epinephrine injections for insect bites or other allergies.

Description of Violation

Resident #1 is prescribed Ozempic Ing. 2mg/ml: inject .25 pen needle subcutaneously one time a day every Friday for weight loss. According to Resident #1's Medication Administration Record (MAR), this medication was administered by Staff Member B on 1/3/25, 1/10/25, 1/17/25, and 1/24/25. Staff Member B is not a licensed professional the home does not have a waiver for administration of GLP-1 subcutaneous injections.

Plan of Correction**Accepted (████) - 02/11/2025)**

PC Admin immediately notified all staff to not administer Ozyempic injections. PC Admin reviewed notification from DHS regarding GLP-1s and their administration. Waiver was applied for and sent via email on 2/7/25. PC Admin is an LPN and will administer injection until waiver decision is given, if waiver is denied PCHA to continue administration. Education of GLP-1 given on 2/7/25 with annual DM training, education also added to Relias. Audits to be completed by PCHA or RN Exec Dir to ensure proper administration. Audits began 2/6/25 and will be weekly until 2/27/25. Then monthly audits to begin 3/20/25 and end 5/15/25.
