Description of Violation

On [REDACTED], Resident [REDACTED] was seen by Staff Member B to be very agitated and acting uncharacteristically. Staff Member B then discussed this with Resident [REDACTED] and Resident [REDACTED] reported that Staff Member A threatened to call the police on them for talking loudly which upset Resident [REDACTED].

Plan of Correction

Accept [REDACTED] - 03/03/2025)

- Staff Member B was officially terminated from employment with FCS on [REDACTED].
- On 2/7/2025 all other program staff were re-trained on "What is Abuse?" and Resident Rights.
- On 2/10/2025, resident [REDACTED] was re-trained on resident rights.
- On 2/25/2025, all program residents were trained on what abuse is; identifying abuse by a HCQU nurse.
- All staff will be trained on resident rights and abuse/mandatory reporting upon hire and annually thereafter.
- All residents will continue to be educated on their rights upon admission and at least annually thereafter.
- The Administrator will ensure ongoing compliance with this regulation.
