182b - Prescription Medication

1. Requirements

2600.

182.b. Prescription medication that is not self-administered by a resident shall be administered by one of the following:

- 4. A staff person who has completed the medication administration training as specified in § 2600.190 (relating to medication administration training) for the administration of oral; topical; eye, nose and ear drop prescription medications; insulin injections and epinephrine injections for insect bites or other allergies.

Description of Violation

On 2/5/25 at 9:00am, Staff Person A administered Ozempic to Resident #1. This staff person is not medically licensed or trained to administer this type of medication.

Plan of Correction

Accept (█ - 02/26/2025)

Immediate action was taken by the Administrator and Director of Nursing on 02/07/2025 to provide a verbal education to licensed staff on duty on administering GLP-1 agonist medications for personal care residents. All licensed staff will be educated prior to or during SNF monthly staff meeting on 03/06/2025 by the Director of Nursing. The Administrator provided an education to all Medtechs on next scheduled shifts on GLP-1 agonist medications and that moving forward the SNF licensed nurses will be utilized to administer such injections. This education was completed by 02/12/2025. Beginning the week of 02/09/2025, the Administrator will conduct audits weekly for one month to maintain ongoing compliance. Beginning 3/10/2025, monthly audits will be completed by the Administrator moving forward. A policy has been created for the administration of GLP-1 agonist injections and provided to staff. Any deficiencies will be corrected immediately, and findings will be documented and reviewed internally for continuous improvement purposes.
