1. Requirements

2600.

92. Windows and Screens - Windows, including windows in doors, must be in good repair and securely screened when doors or windows are open.

Description of Violation

Multiple functioning windows did not have screens, to include the two 2nd floor windows above the porch.

Plan of Correction

Directed (█) - 04/23/2025

By 5/13/25, the administrator or designee will ensure screens are in place and in good repair, for all operable windows in the home. Documentation will be kept.

By 5/13/25, the administrator will reeducate all staff regarding the requirement that operable windows must be in good repair and securely screened. Documentation will be kept.

By 5/13/25 and monthly thereafter, the administrator or designee will monitor the home to ensure all operable windows are in good repair and are securely screened. Documentation will be kept.

103f - Refrigerator/Freezer Temps

2. Requirements

2600.

103.f. Food requiring refrigeration shall be stored at or below 40°F. Frozen food shall be kept at or below 0°F. Thermometers are required in refrigerators and freezers.

Description of Violation

The thermometer in the main kitchen's stand-up freezer was inoperable and did not change temperature when moved.

Plan of Correction

Directed (█) - 04/23/2025

By 4/24/25, the administrator or designee will ensure there is an operable thermometer in the main kitchen stand-up freezer. Documentation will be kept.

By 4/25/25 and daily thereafter, the administrator or designee will monitor the main kitchen's stand up freezer to ensure a thermometer is present and the temperature does not exceed 0 degrees Fahrenheit. Documentation will be kept.

By 5/13/25, the administrator will reeducate all staff regarding the requirement that food requiring refrigeration must be stored at or below 40°F, frozen food shall be kept at or below 0°F and thermometers are required in refrigerators and freezers.

2600.

187a - Medication Record (continued)

187.a. A medication record shall be kept to include the following for each resident for whom medications are administered:

- 8. Frequency of administration.

Description of Violation

Resident #1 was prescribed Hyoscyamine 0.125 mg tablet, place 1 tablet under the tongue every 4 hours as needed for secretions. However, the resident's March 2025 medication administration record indicates take every 6 hours as needed.

Plan of Correction

Directed ([REDACTED] - 04/23/2025)

By 4/25/25, the administrator will update resident #1's MAR to match the prescriber's order.

By 5/13/25, the administrator will reeducate all staff regarding the information required to be present on a resident MAR, to include frequency of administration, in accordance with §2600.187a(1-14). Documentation will be kept.

By 5/13/25 and monthly thereafter, the administrator or designee qualified to administer medication will audit all resident MARs to ensure they match the prescriber's order. Documentation will be kept.
