227d - Support Plan Medical/Dental

1. Requirements

2600.

227.d. Each home shall document in the resident’s support plan the medical, dental, vision, hearing, mental health or other behavioral care services that will be made available to the resident, or referrals for the resident to outside services if the resident’s physician, physician’s assistant or certified registered nurse practitioner, determine the necessity of these services. This requirement does not require a home to pay for the cost of these medical and behavioral care services.

Description of Violation

Resident [redacted] is a person with advanced [redacted]. Staff reported that resident [redacted] becomes more confused at night and is prone to [redacted]. Resident [redacted] also has a history of falls and uses a low bed with fall mats. Resident [redacted] support plan, dated [redacted] does not include how these needs will be met.

On 3/7/2025 all staff were educated on regulation 227d by the PCHA . On 3/7/2025 PCHA updated resident [redacted] support plan to include confusion at night and a plan for staff to redirect the resident or orient to surroundings, as well as history of falls requiring use of fall mats, and low bed to ensure compliance with regulation 227d.

PCHA will conduct 5 random audits of resident support plans monthly for 3 months to ensure ongoing compliance with regulation 227d. Documentation of these audits shall be retained by the PCHA.

Education on regulation 2600.227d will continue with staff monthly for 3 months and then annually thereafter. PCHA will retain documentation of the staff education in accordance with 2600.65i. The monthly staff training shall begin on 3/10/2025 and shall include training for all current staff persons.
