82a - Poisonous Materials

1. Requirements

2600.

82.a. Poisonous materials shall be stored in their original, labeled containers.

Description of Violation

At 10:16 a.m., there was a spray bottle containing approximately 250 mls of green liquid in the unlocked, unattended and accessible housekeeping cart in the entrance to the dining room. There was no manufacturer's label on the bottle.

Plan of Correction

2600.82.a

The spray bottle containing 250mls of green liquid that was identified during survey on 3/11/2025 was immediately emptied and disposed of on that date. Educated staff member that she was not to use chemicals that are not clearly labeled with manufacturers warning label. On 3/11/2025 the Administrator looked through the cart and did not identify any other bottles that did not have a manufacturers label on it. The administrator provided education on why manufacturers label is important for all chemicals/hazardous materials on 3/18/2025. Education will be kept in the employees' file. The administrator will complete weekly audits of the housekeeping carts to ensure that all chemicals/hazardous materials have the proper manufacturers label on them, these will begin on 3/18/2025 and the completed audits will be kept in the plan of correction binder. The administrator will review the plan of correction at the 4/11/2025 Quality Management Monthly Meeting and a copy of the minutes will be kept in the plan of correction binder as well.

82c - Locking Poisonous Materials

2. Requirements

2600.

82.c. Poisonous materials shall be kept locked and inaccessible to residents unless all of the residents living in the home are able to safely use or avoid poisonous materials.

Description of Violation

At approximately 10:16 a.m., there was an unlocked, unattended and accessible housekeeping cart in the entrance to the dining room that contained the following:

** A bottle with approximately 1/2 cup of Lysol multi-surface cleaner with label that indicates "If SWALLOWED, drink 1-2 glasses of water and call a physician or poison control center ..."*

** An aerosol spray can of Vista Clear Glass Cleaner with label that indicates "If inhaled: Remove victim to fresh air and keep at rest . . . Call a POISON CENTER or doctor if you feel unwell."*

Resident [REDACTED] is not assessed as being able to safely use and avoid poisonous material.

Plan of Correction

2600.82.c

The 1/2 bottle of Lysol multi-surface cleaner and the aerosol spray can of vista clear glass cleaner were immediately locked up and housekeeping staff secured the housekeeping cart by locking it at that time. Educated staff member that if she is not with the cart it must be locked at all times. No other unsecured poisonous materials identified. The administrator provided the housekeeper with education on securing poisonous substances on 3/18/2025. Education

will be kept in the housekeeper's employee file. The administrator or designee will complete weekly walking rounds to identify and to ensure poisonous substances are secured. The weekly walking round audits will begin on 3/18/2025 and the completed audits will be kept in the plan of correction binder. The administrator will review the plan of correction at the 4/11/2025 Quality Management Monthly Meeting. A copy of the minutes will be kept in the plan of correction binder as well.
