23.a. A home shall provide each resident with assistance with ADLs as indicated in the resident's assessment and support plan.

Description of Violation

The assessment and support plan dated [redacted], for resident [redacted] indicates the resident requires assistance with toileting, transfers, and ambulating. On [redacted] to [redacted], from 10:00 pm. to 6:45 am., the resident did not receive this assistance as required.

On [redacted], at 6:45 am. resident [redacted] was found on the floor next to [redacted] bed in a puddle of urine, with a urine-soaked nightgown, brief, and blanket. Resident [redacted] bed clothing was also urine soaked.

On 3/28/2025 the administrator [redacted] had a mandatory staff meeting to go over what a RASP was, job description and duties, resident checks, documentation, and rounding with one another.

On 3/28/2025 the administrator [redacted] created sheets to be used to show that the residents are being checked on and that they are being changed and assisted.

Starting on 3/28/2025 the administrator [redacted] will do a yearly training with all the staff and an initial training with new staff to ensure that they know what a RASP is and training on ADLs to before they hit the floor.
