On [REDACTED], Resident [REDACTED], a Hospice resident, was in bed. Resident [REDACTED] entered the room and placed a pillow over their face and tried to smother them with the pillow. Resident [REDACTED] has had another altercation with another resident on [REDACTED] where an injury was noted.

On [REDACTED] Resident [REDACTED] was immediately separated from resident [REDACTED] and placed under 1:1 supervision. PCP made aware of incident and requested labs and medication review. [REDACTED] Medication review completed by PCP and resident [REDACTED] labwork was positive for [REDACTED], resident was started on [REDACTED] x 5 days for [REDACTED], [REDACTED] daily for [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] daily for [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] discontinued due to adverse reaction and was started on [REDACTED] once daily. [REDACTED] was increased to 1mg. [REDACTED] Resident was started on [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] daily to prevent [REDACTED]. Resident remained with private duty until [REDACTED] when [REDACTED] was moved into a private apartment in memory care unit. Frequent checks continue to be made by staff.
