42b - Abuse

1. Requirements

2600.

42.b. A resident may not be neglected, intimidated, physically or verbally abused, mistreated, subjected to corporal punishment or disciplined in any way.

Description of Violation

On [REDACTED] Staff person A stole [REDACTED] from Resident [REDACTED] apartment and proceeded to make purchases at several local establishments using those cards. Purchases made include, an iPad, a case, watch, groceries, sandwiches/drinks, and items from a Wine & Spirits store. The staff persons image was captured on store footage and local police and the County District Attorney's Office are investigating and will be pursuing charges against Staff person A regarding the theft of Resident [REDACTED]'s personal property.

Plan of Correction

Accept [REDACTED] - 06/09/2025)

Administrator took immediate action to involve the Northampton Borough police asking for full investigation of the theft of credit cards from resident [REDACTED] and to begin processes to protect all residents of the community from theft. The following actions were instituted...

Security:

Security cameras were installed throughout all hallways and outside of the community. Continued monitoring of these cameras have been assigned to our Maintenance Director, Nursing Director and Administrator.

Termination of Involved Employees:

Termination of any employee implicated with this incident have been terminated from their positions on March 20, 2025. Shift coverage for all terminated employees was arranged without interruption of care to any resident.

Notification to residents and family:

Notices in letter form and email were sent to all residents and responsible parties informing them of incident and immediate action taken as well as future plans for security.

Safes installed:

Small personal safes were installed in every unit within the community. These units are locked by key pad code, not keys. Residents are to use safe for personal cash, valuables and any item needing safekeeping. Codes may be given to the Main Office/Administrator or family member. Codes will be recorded in Resident Admission File located in Administrator's office. Keys to the safes are labeled with room numbers and kept in a locked cabinet in the Administration Office. Access to keys will be given to Maint Director, Admissions Director and Administrator. If a safe is not accessible or wanted by resident, a locking nightstand drawer is provided as alternative.

Continued Safety Discussion:

Resident Council meeting held every other month will include reminders of safekeeping and security. All Administrative Directors will be encouraged to promote security and safekeeping to all residents.

Future Prosecution of Charged Individual:

A hearing at the Magistrates Office occurred on May30, 2025 at 9:30AM. Resident [REDACTED] and Administrator were subpoenaed to appear for testimony that a crime had been committed against Resident [REDACTED] Administrator, Admissions Director and [REDACTED] of Resident were present during this process. Due to the Defendant's absence of Public Defense Attny, the case was waived and will continue to the District Attorney for further processing. At this hearing, we were informed by Magistrate District Judge [REDACTED] and Detective [REDACTED] that Resident or Administrator will have no further involvement in the processing of the Defendant (LG). charges are pending of the individual.

Future Plan:

The community will not tolerate any theft, financial abuse of any resident. Strict employee action will be taken for any individual who is accused or suspected of such acts. Immediate suspension will occur while investigation is in process. Charges will be filed appropriately.
