15b - Supervisor Plan

1. Requirements

2600.

15.b. If there is an allegation of abuse of a resident involving a home's staff person, the home shall immediately develop and implement a plan of supervision or suspend the staff person involved in the alleged incident.

Description of Violation

On [REDACTED] at approximately 1:00 p.m. Protective Services notified the home of an allegation of verbal abuse by direct care staff person A, the assistant director of wellness, against resident [REDACTED]. Direct care staff person A was placed immediately on a plan of supervision created by the home that was not approved by the Department of Aging or Department of Human Services. Direct care staff person A continued to work in the home until approximately 3:00 p.m. Additionally, direct care staff person A worked unsupervised on [REDACTED] from approximately 7:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m. and on [REDACTED] from approximately 7:00 a.m. until 9:00 a.m. until being placed on a plan of supervision that was prompted by and approved by the Department of Human Services.

Plan of Correction

Violation 2600.15.b.

On April 2, 2025, the Executive Director educated the Director of Wellness of the procedures involving development and implementation of a plan of supervision when investigating an alleged incident.

Additionally, on April 3, 2025, a new policy was implemented that is in accordance with 2600.15b to ensure ongoing compliance and it will be reviewed with all the staff on Monday, April 14 by the ED. The Executive Director and Director will be responsible for ongoing compliance.

Moving forward starting May 1, 2025, any abuse allegations will result in a suspension from the facility or placed on a Plan of Supervision in lieu of suspension under the supervision of the Director of Wellness until allegations are unfounded. In the event of any allegation all documentation will be kept by the Director of Wellness in a binder in [REDACTED] office. Also beginning May 1, 2025, the Director of Wellness for the next 3 months will also conduct weekly interviews with five residents a week to ensure care standards are met, all documentation with resident interviews will be kept in a binder in the Director of Wellness office.

95. Furniture and Equipment - Furniture and equipment must be in good repair, clean and free of hazards.

Description of Violation

At approximately 9:07 a.m., the keypad on the door alarm for the emergency exit door opposite of the home's main entry way in the front lounge was missing the key for the number three and the alarm could not be silenced without

entering a code using the number three.

In reference to violation 2600.95,

Upon notification of the keypad malfunction on April 1, 2025 by the inspector to the Executive Director, the maintenance department was immediately notified, and a new alarm entry system was installed on April 1, 2025 before the exit interview was conducted on April 1 by the Maintenance Director. Moreover, please note that weekly checks by the Maintenance Director will be performed. moving forward. A new automated procedure has been put into place as of April 2. The Executive Director will be responsible for entering the work orders and the Maintenance Director will be responsible for ensuring timely completion of all work orders to ensure ongoing compliance with 2600.95. The Maintenance Supervisor and Executive Director will check daily to ensure equipment in need of repairs is fixed in accordance with regulations
