42.b. A resident may not be neglected, intimidated, physically or verbally abused, mistreated, subjected to corporal punishment or disciplined in any way.

Description of Violation

On [REDACTED], Resident [REDACTED] DOA [REDACTED] pushed Resident [REDACTED] [REDACTED] with both hands in the chest causing a fall that resulted in a head injury.

Plan of Correction

On [REDACTED] Resident [REDACTED] DOB [REDACTED] was immediately separated from Resident [REDACTED] DOB [REDACTED]. Resident [REDACTED] was sent to LVH-Hecktown Oaks Emergency Room for an evaluation due to a head injury from the altercation. Both POA/Designees of Resident [REDACTED] & [REDACTED] contacted at time of incident. Incident reported to Northampton County Area on Aging, DHS, and Nazareth Police Department. Resident [REDACTED] was placed on ATC 15-minute checks to ensure no contact between Resident [REDACTED] and Resident [REDACTED]. On 3/28/2025, a 30-day notice for relocation was sent Certified and Standard mail to Resident [REDACTED] POA/Designee. Resident [REDACTED] was monitored after hospital discharge for signs and symptoms of s/p head injury and re-evaluated by PCP, [REDACTED] on [REDACTED]. On [REDACTED], Resident [REDACTED] was immediately transferred to our sister facility located in Bath, PA with 30-day notice in effect. Moving forward, Administrator, [REDACTED], and Assistant Administrator, [REDACTED] will perform Resident-Resident Interaction Audits, once weekly x 4; bi-weekly x 4; then monthly x 4 to ensure compliance with DHS Regulations are maintained. During Quality Management Meeting 3/21/2025, Admission Policies and Procedures discussed to further evaluate potential Residents before admission to help decrease any risk and maintain ongoing compliance with DHS Regulations. Facility Ombudsman contacted to schedule Annual Abuse, Neglect, and Resident Rights class for all staff to further educate and maintain ongoing compliance with DHS Regulations.
