2600.

Resident [REDACTED] most recent Assessment and Support Plan, dated [REDACTED], indicates that the resident needs assistance for transferring but the support plan does not contain information about Resident requiring a 2 person assist for transferring.

**Plan of Correction****Accept [REDACTED] - 05/01/2025)**

*Action: The resident did have a 2-person assist listed on Point Click Care and Point of Care service plan and tasks which are viewed and signed off by direct care staff every shift. The Executive Director updated the residents' Assessment and Support Plan which was completed on 4/15/2025.*

*Training: The Executive Director will educate the clinical leadership team on regulation 2600.227.d by 5/9/2025.*

*Ongoing: Starting indefinitely on 5/1/2025, the Executive Director, Director of Nursing, and/or Assistant Director of Nursing will utilize a tracking spreadsheet to review and update all Resident Assessment and Support Plan's. This will ensure all changes in level of care are reflected on the residents support plan to best suit the residents' needs and remain in compliance with 2600.227.d. The Leadership team will discuss and review regulation 2600.227.d during the Quality Assurance meeting to be held during the month of June 2025.*
