On 04/15/25 the inspector educated the administrator on the window and screen requirements set by the State of Pennsylvania. On 04/19/25 the administrator purchased and installed all new screens for each window that required a replacement screen. Effective 04/19/25 to ensure future compliance, the administrative assistant will conduct an inspection every 6 months on each window and screen in the facility. To ensure compliance as well as ensuring each window and screen is secure and in good repair the administrator assistant will complete a biannual window and door check off list.
