2. Requirements

2600.

144.c. A home that permits smoking inside or outside of the home shall develop and implement written fire safety policy and procedures that include the following:

1. Proper safeguards inside and outside of the home to prevent fire hazards involved in smoking, including providing fireproof receptacles and ashtrays, direct outside ventilation, no interior ventilation from the smoking room through other parts of the home, extinguishing procedures, fire resistant furniture both inside and outside the home and fire extinguishers in the smoking rooms.

Description of Violation

The home's designated smoking area is at the picnic tables in the parking lot. At approximately 1:20 p.m. 4 cigarette butts were noted in the stones off the back porch.

Plan of Correction

Immediately staff cleaned the cigarette butts in the smoking area and the surrounding areas. A staff meeting was held on 5-19-25 to review and discuss the violation and protocols moving forward.
