During an unannounced visit for POC Submission compliance, it was determined that one of the POCs that were submitted were not completed. The annual training for one of the employees was not able to be completed by an outside agency. After speaking with the inspector(s), it was determined that because [REDACTED] and I are both nurses, I could train [REDACTED] and vice versa, on the annual training. Because [REDACTED] is a LPN nurse, we didn't believe that [REDACTED] needed the same training as a regular DCS staff person. On 4/29/25, [REDACTED], Administrator, held training for this staff person to be in compliance with PA Code 2600.65f. Documentation was obtained on this training. In order for the training to be compliant moving forward, as disclosed in another training POC, this employee will sit in on all future trainings being provided by an outside source. Any in house trainings will be provided by the Administrator so that the employee is able to attend the training, as well. This will ensure that ALL staff members are trained appropriately moving forward. Documentation will be kept in accordance with PA Code 2600.65f
