82c - Locking Poisonous Materials

1. Requirements

2600.

82.c. Poisonous materials shall be kept locked and inaccessible to residents unless all of the residents living in the home are able to safely use or avoid poisonous materials.

Description of Violation

Clorox cleaner with bleach, Soft Scrub with Bleach and "SW" Clorox, with a manufacture's label indicating "POISON do not ingest. Call a poison Control Center or Physician immediately.", was unlocked, unattended, and accessible to residents. Not all the residents of the home have been assessed capable of recognizing and using poisons safely.

Plan of Correction

Accept (█ - 06/10/2025)

- * All housekeeping staff were re-trained on keeping all poisonous materials locked when not using on 4/29/2025 by Administrator.
- * Going forward, housekeeping staff will ensure that all poisonous materials that are not being personally supervised during use will be locked in a safe area.
- * Administrator will monitor for ongoing compliance and provide annual training to all staff, including housekeeping, on the regulation to ensure poisonous materials that are unsupervised must be locked for resident safety.

2. Requirements

2600.

102.f. An individual towel, washcloth and soap shall be provided for each resident.

Description of Violation

At approximately 11:05 am in Bathroom █ there was no hand soap available to be used by residents, staff or visitors using the bathroom.

Plan of Correction

Accept (█ - 06/10/2025)

- * A new hand soap was immediately placed in bathroom █ on 4/29/2025 by housekeeping staff.
- * Housekeeping staff were re-trained on the need for hand soap in all common bathrooms and will check all bathrooms during scheduled shifts.
- * All residents were reminded at resident council meeting that soap dispensers must be left in the common bathrooms.
- * Administrator will do daily walk through of building, including check of all common bathrooms, during administration hours to monitor for ongoing compliance.
