2600.

227.d. [REDACTED] has been told by [REDACTED] to use the skills [REDACTED] has been taught when [REDACTED] is having some metal health issues. DCS will monitor for any changes in [REDACTED] mental heath daily and encourage [REDACTED] and remind [REDACTED] to focus and use [REDACTED] coping skills [REDACTED] has been taught, if the issues are not being resolved DCS will report all changes to [REDACTED]. Please see the attached updated RASP. Resident [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] RASP was updated on May 7, 2025 by the Administrator ([REDACTED]) to include how the resident's MH needs will be met. On May 15, 2025 the Administrator ([REDACTED]) meet with all DCS, we had a meeting to discuss the importance of keeping the RASP updated for any significantly changes that are seen with a resident prior to the annual assessment, where the RASP are located, how to read the RASP, and the importance of reviewing the RASP on a regular basis. May 15, 2025 moving forward the administrator will continue to follow-up with any questions the staff may have to a RASP on a regular basis.
