2600.187d – Follow Prescriber's Orders

- Facility is unable to correct incorrect insulin given to Resident [REDACTED] on 4/9/25.
- Facility is unable to correct incorrect medication given to Resident [REDACTED] on 4/30/25.
- Education given by PCHA or Designee the week of 5/19/25 to all Med Techs on insulin sliding scale and following prescribers orders.
- Reportables completed on 5/19/25 for medication errors found during DHS inspection.
- Resident care coordinator will be responsible for contacting the medical director for all changes/concerns regarding resident treatments, care and medications. Med Techs are to report changes/concerns to RCC, PCHA or PC Director immediately to ensure concerns/changes are addressed immediately. RCC to start officially in position the week of 4/28/25, until that time PCHA and/or Designee will step in to provide medical director with changes/concerns for residents.
- Med techs completed Diabetic Training on 5/7/25 and 5/13/25.
- Starting the week of 5/19/25, audits will be conducted 1 day per week for 10 weeks on all diabetic residents to ensure correct insulin units were provided based on blood sugar reading.
- Starting the week of 5/26/25, MAR audits will be conducted by PCHA/Designee 2x a week for 4 weeks and then 1x a week for 4 weeks on 5 residents to ensure that the MAR matches prescriber's orders as written
