Description of Violation

Resident # 1 has an order for insulin to be administered on a sliding scale basis before meals and at bedtime. The Libre Freestyle 3 glucometer does not retain a daily log of all blood glucose readings documented for resident # 1's sliding scale insulin administration.

Plan of Correction**Accept (█ - 07/21/2025)**

Resident now has a Libre 3 app on █ phone that is capable of recording █ readings. Resident and staff ensure readings are logged correctly. Staff is able to access past readings. RCD will ensure readings are recorded unless resident refuses access to █ phone. If access to the phone is refused resident has a manual accu check machine.
