121.a. Stairways, hallways, doorways, passageways and egress routes from rooms and from the building must be unlocked and unobstructed.

Description of Violation

At 9:44am, the emergency exit door at the bottom of the stairs from the administrative office to the front yard was manually locked.

On 5/13/25 at 9:45 AM, the emergency exit door from PCHA office was unlocked.

On 5/13/25 at 9:50 AM, the PCHA made rounds and ensured all emergencies, stairways, hallways, egress routes doors were unlocked and unobstructed.

On 5/14/25 at 10:AM the PCHA held a 30 Mins QA meeting. Agenda, recent state inspection due to a complain. One deficiency was found, emergency door near PCHA office was locked.

POC, educated DCS on 2600.

Beginning 5/14/25, DCS will make rounds during the beginning of each shift to ensure all stairways, hallways, doorways, passageways and egress routes from rooms and from the building are unlocked and unobstructed.

Daily X 1 Week, Twice a Week, Weekly X 4 Weeks then Monthly X 1 Month. (See attached completed audit)

PCHA will continue to educate DCS during QA meeting and perform random rounds to ensure stairways, hallways, doorways, passageways and egress routes from rooms and from the building are unlocked and unobstructed.
