Your request to waive 55 Pa. Code § 2600.22(1) and (2), § 2600.141(a), § 2600.224(a) and § 2600.231 is granted under the authority of 55 Pa.Code § 2600.19 due to The Atrium of Allentown choosing to use the preadmission and documentation of medical evaluation forms from TabulaPro.

2600.22 Admission

The following admission documents shall be completed for each resident:

- (1) Preadmission screening completed prior to admission on a form specified by the Department.
- (2) Medical evaluation completed 60 days prior to or 30 days after admission on a form specified by the Department.

2600.141 Resident medical evaluation and health care

(a) A resident shall have a medical evaluation by a physician, physician assistant or certified registered nurse practitioner documented on a form specified by the Department, within 60 days.

2600.224 Preadmission screening

(a) A determination shall be made within 30 dates prior to admission and documented on the Department's preadmission screening form that the needs of the resident can be met by the services provided by the home.

2600.231 Admission

(a) A resident shall have a medical evaluation by a physician, physician's assistant or certified registered nurse practitioner, documented on a form provided by the Department, within 60 days prior to admission. Documentation shall include the resident's diagnosis of Alzheimer's disease or other dementia and the need for the resident to be served in a secured dementia care unit.

This waiver is granted under the following conditions:

1. The Atrium of Allentown shall use the preadmission screening form and documentation of medical evaluation form from TabulaPro in lieu of the Department's forms.

The Department of Human Services will review this waiver during its annual inspection to determine compliance with the preceding conditions. Failure to comply with the conditions of this waiver or with other requirements of 55 Pa. Code Chapter 2600 may result in termination of this waiver or other licensing action.
