On [redacted] at 9:00 P.M., the home did not administer the correct dosage of [redacted] for resident [redacted]. Resident [redacted] is prescribed .5mg tablet at bedtime but received 1mg of [redacted] instead.

This regulation was violated because Resident [redacted] and Resident # [redacted] are prescribed blood glucose readings daily at 4:00 P.M. However, residents [redacted] and [redacted] were not administered their glucose checks on [redacted] at 4:00 P.M and On 5/15/25 at 9:00 P.M., the home did not administer the correct dosage of [redacted] for resident [redacted]. To fix this problem: Reportable incident sent to DHS regarding medication error. Families and PCP notified of medication error on 5/16/2025.

To be sure this incident does not occur again, education held with employee by Resident Care Director [redacted] on 5/16/2025. Administrator, [redacted] and Resident Care Director [redacted] are responsible for maintaining ongoing compliance with this regulation
