Description of Violation

At 2:05p.m. there was an unlabeled and undated tube of meat, plastic bag of chicken, and plastic bag of tater tots in the kitchen freezer.

Plan of Correction

This violation occurred when the sealed items were removed from their labeled/dated boxes to provide more space for storage in the freezer. The Dietary staff failed to label/date the items upon removal from their compliant boxes. Items were labeled/dated appropriately at time of inspection.

The Dietary staff were educated on 5/29/25 to ensure ongoing compliance with regulation 103e. (see attachment)

The Shift Cook will also be responsible to conduct daily audits to enhance ongoing compliance.
