At 9:47a.m., there was a full, uncovered, unattended trash can in the North Wing communal restroom.

During walk through of building a garbage can in one of the North wing bathrooms was found without its lid on it. A resident who frequent uses the bathroom removes the lid while throwing away toilet paper. When administrator was notified the lid was placed back on the garbage can and the rest of the facilities bathrooms were checked to meet compliance with DHS regulations. Moving forward, night shift will continue to check bathrooms upon final rounds of the day and well as first and second shift in passing to make sure all lids are properly on garbage cans.

Administrator also spoke with resident on importance of keeping the lip on the garbage can to meet DHS regulations. Any issues staff with notify administrator and it will be handled immediately.

During time of inspection a can of frozen biscuits was found to be out of date. The can was immediately thrown away. Staff nightly/ weekly will continue to monitor and check all refrigerators and freezers to ensure all food isn't expired and thrown away in a timely matter. A check list is kept in the kitchen for staff to fill out nightly with any issues or findings and administrator reviews weekly to ensure compliance with DHS regulations.
