1. Requirements

2600.

187.d. The home shall follow the directions of the prescriber.

Description of Violation

Resident [REDACTED] is prescribed [REDACTED] by mouth on [REDACTED] then start [REDACTED] one tablet by mouth twice daily. However, on dates to include [REDACTED], and [REDACTED] resident [REDACTED] was administered one dose of [REDACTED] tablets at approximately 9:00 a.m. and was not administered a second daily dose.

Plan of Correction

2600.187d. The home shall follow the directions of the prescriber.

Description of violation on [REDACTED]: Resident [REDACTED] is prescribed [REDACTED] by mouth on 5/22/25, then start one tablet by mouth twice daily. However, on dates to include 5/23/25, 5/24/25, 5/25/25, and 5/27/25, resident #1 was administered one dose of [REDACTED] 90mg tablet at approximately 9:00am and was not administered a second daily dose.

Family and physician were notified of medication error by LPN on 5/28/2025 as noted in resident progress notes at 6:53pm and are part of the resident's permanent file as of 5/28/2025.

Initial incident was reported to DHS by PCHA on 5/28/2025 at 7:20pm.

On 6/23/25, Executive Director began training current nursing staff to new policy outlining how to ensure medications are transcribed into Emar accurately.

Updated Policy states: To verify all new medication orders of the day were transcribed into Emar accurately (only nurses and PCHA have permissions within Emar to enter doctor's orders) the nurse working the 3pm-11pm and/or the 11pm to 7am shift will indicate they have double checked the doctor's order, compare to Emar, initial and date doctor's order, then mark order with red-line to indicate the order has been verified a second time. Order will then be scanned into resident file.

Home shall adhere to 2600.187d. The home shall follow the directions of the prescriber.

Current nursing staff training completed training to new process on 7/6/2025 indicating they understand the new process by signing training form. Any new nurses will be trained to process as part of onboarding. Copies will be kept in individual employee files.

Monitoring/audits of adherence to this policy will be completed weekly by PCHA or PCHA appointed nurse beginning 7/8/25. Documentation will be filed in POC binder located in PCHA office. PCHA completed audit on 7/8/2025 and noted Document is stored in POC binder in PCHA office.
